- **Oral presentation decisive in case of draw on the basis of the full paper**
- **Winner announced at Award ceremony**

Didier Patte Award

- **Aims to reward a scientific work of outstanding merit within the shoulder and elbow community**
 - Should consist of body of several original studies on the same or related topic.
 - Single studies are not eligible.
 - At least part of the work should not have been published before the submission deadline.
 - The principal author should be under the age of 45.
- **Every two years: next call 2019 (by 30/06/2019)**
- **Stimulate young surgeons, esp PhD's, to submit**
