



Registry Committee Report

September 2018

Dear Colleagues,

The Registry committee is still a brand new committee created during SECEC 2016. It started with B Werner (Germany), B Salomonsson (Sweden), J Rees (UK), L Beimers (Netherlands), L Favard (France) and C Torrens (Spain). Lucky us, last September 2017 we could also have J Rasmussen (Denmark) with us.

As defined by Luc, the first role of the committee was to explain what a registry is, to explain why it is important to have a registry and to explain how to interpret the results of a registry.

To accomplish these purposes we first tried to build an European Map of Registries. We did a survey among National Delegates to know how many European countries already had a register, if it was national or regional and if it involved shoulder and elbow or just one of them. Now we have a completed map of the European Registries and the results of this survey will be presented during the 2018 SECEC meeting in Geneva as part of the ICL « Ask the Registry ».

As it has been said before, we applied to make an ICL during the SECEC-Geneve meeting and we have now the opportunity to present the ICL « Ask the Registry » that will try to answer some arthroplasty-questions and hopefully will arise new arthroplasty-questions to work with the next year. The faculty of the ICL will be the members of the Committee.

Members of the Committee are with relationship with the ISCA (International Shoulder Arthroplasty consortium). Björn also will be in charge of a shoulder arthroplasty registry session during the next ICSES 2019.

The Committee has also started working on the minimal data set of the existing registers in Europe. Jeppe will send an abstract based on that for the next ICSES 2019.

The main purpose for the next year will be to have the minimal data set running and recruiting information from all existing European registries and being able to elaborate reports that can be posted in the SECEC-web.

During the ICL in Geneva we plan to have time to have feed-back with the audience and maybe incorporate new ideas from the audience to be developed the next year.
